



How to downgrade your iPod Classic 6th generation on Windows NT/2000/2003/XP

V3.0

In order to have the full compatibility with our interfaces for iPod Classic 6th G, it is necessary to be sure that your iPod works with the Apple software series 1.0.1, 1.0.2 or 1.0.3. Newer version are not supported.

Here follow it's described the procedure that allows you to downgrade the iPod.

To make the iPod firmware downgrade (example version 1.1 or following), please follow these steps:

1. Make a complete backup of all files (music, videos etc.) of your ipod.
2. Make a reset of the ipod by activating and disactivating "HOLD" button of the IPOD then by pressing and keep pressed in the same time "MENU" and "SELECT" till when an APPLE appears on the ipod display.
3. Open iTunes, and click on **Edit > Preferences > General** and delete the selection on '**Check for updates automatically**'. ***CLOSE ITUNES***.
4. Close Internet connection if are using a modem ADSL or remote connection. If you are using a Router for internet access disable the Lan/Wi-fi network or disconnect the network cable.
5. Open computer resources, make double click on the hard disk icon where it's installed your Operation System, and follows this:
X:\Documents and Settings*Your Name*\Application Data\Apple Computer\iTunes\iPod Software Updates.
If the folder "iPod Software Updates" is not available, create it with the same exactly name in the position: **X:\Documents and Settings*Your Name*\Application Data\Apple Computer\iTunes\.**
NB: if the folder "Application data" it is not visible, make click on Tools > Folder Options > goes to Brows and active "Show hidden files and folders". Repet step 5.
6. Delete the files (or move in a new folder) **iPod_24.x.x.ipsw** and **Pod_24.x.x.ipsw.signature**. Eventually if are present newer version of ipsw please dolete of move in another folder.
7. If not present in the folder download ([link](#)) and put the **iPod_24.1.0.2.ipsw** file **iPod_24.1.0.2.ipsw.signature** into the folder described in the step 5.
8. Collegare l' iPod al PC e aprire iTunes.
9. Selezionare il proprio ipod e fare click su "**Ripristina**"

10. iTunes will notify that the verifying of new software in not set up in automatic, click **DON'T CHECK.**
11. iTunes will notify that it's possible to make the upgrade to the software version more recent (1.0.2). Click "**USE OLDER VERSION**"
12. iTunes will ask for the RESTORE. Click "RESTORE"
13. Finished the UPGRADE, verify on the iPod that the software version is 1.0.2.
